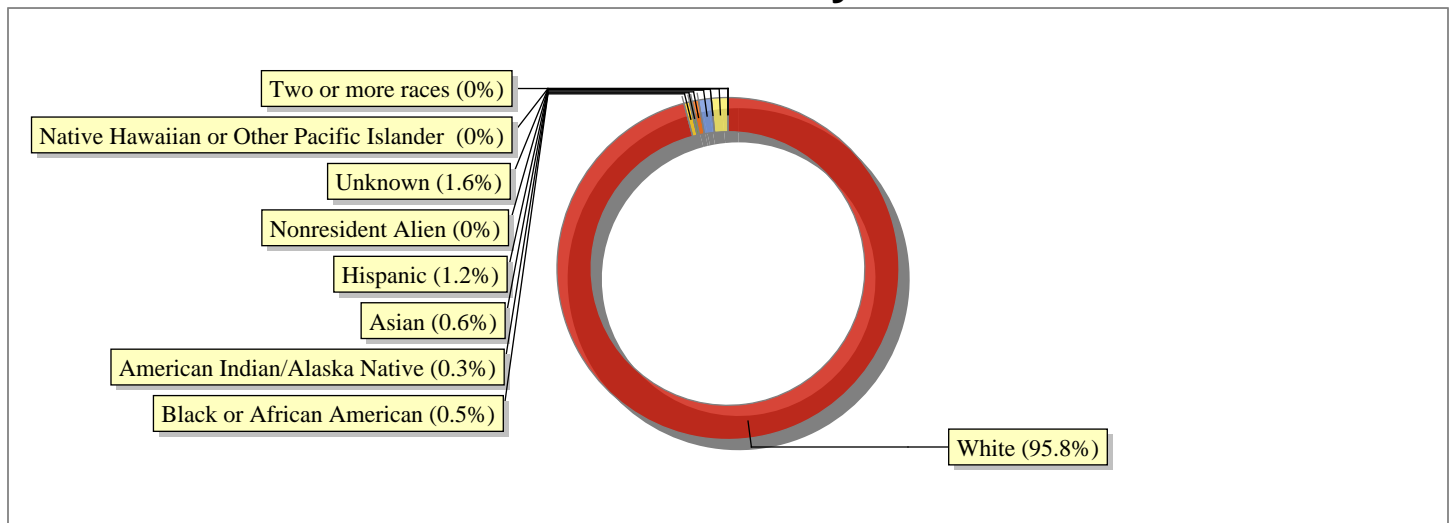

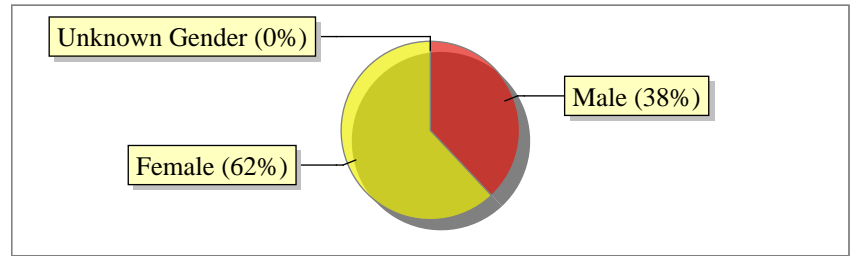

% Gender



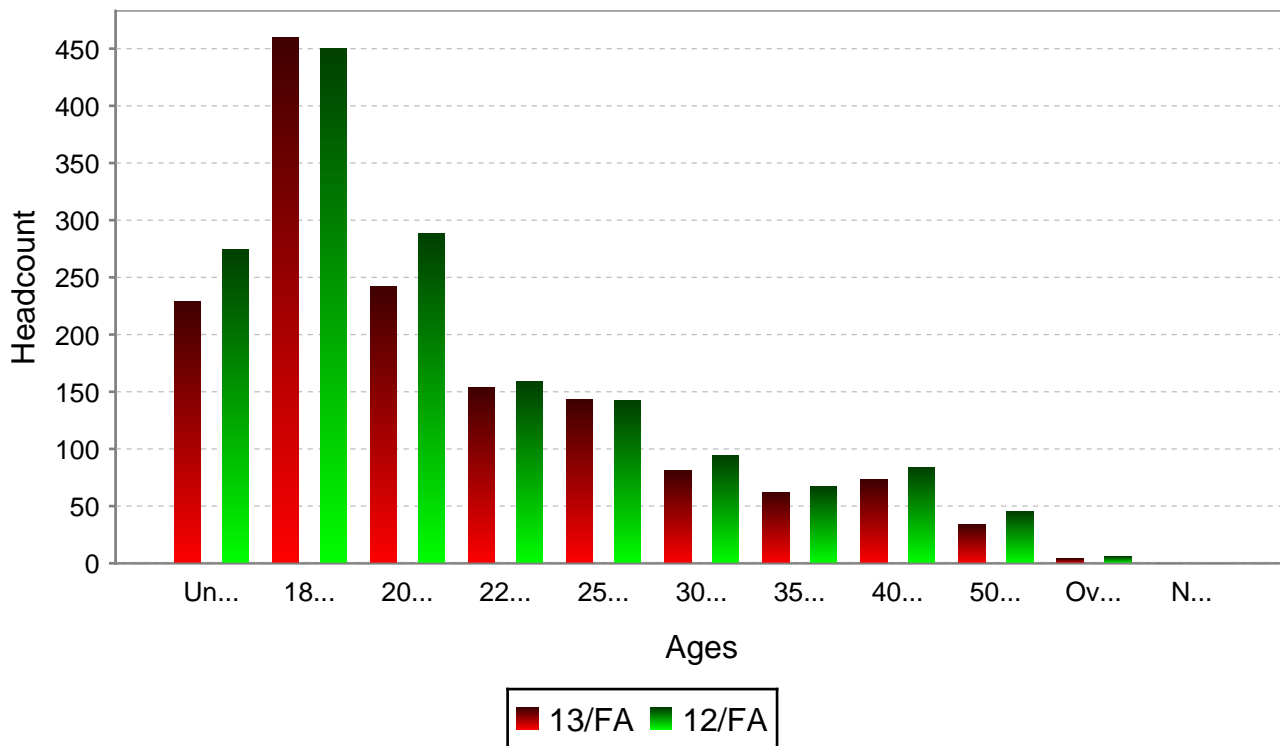

Male Ages



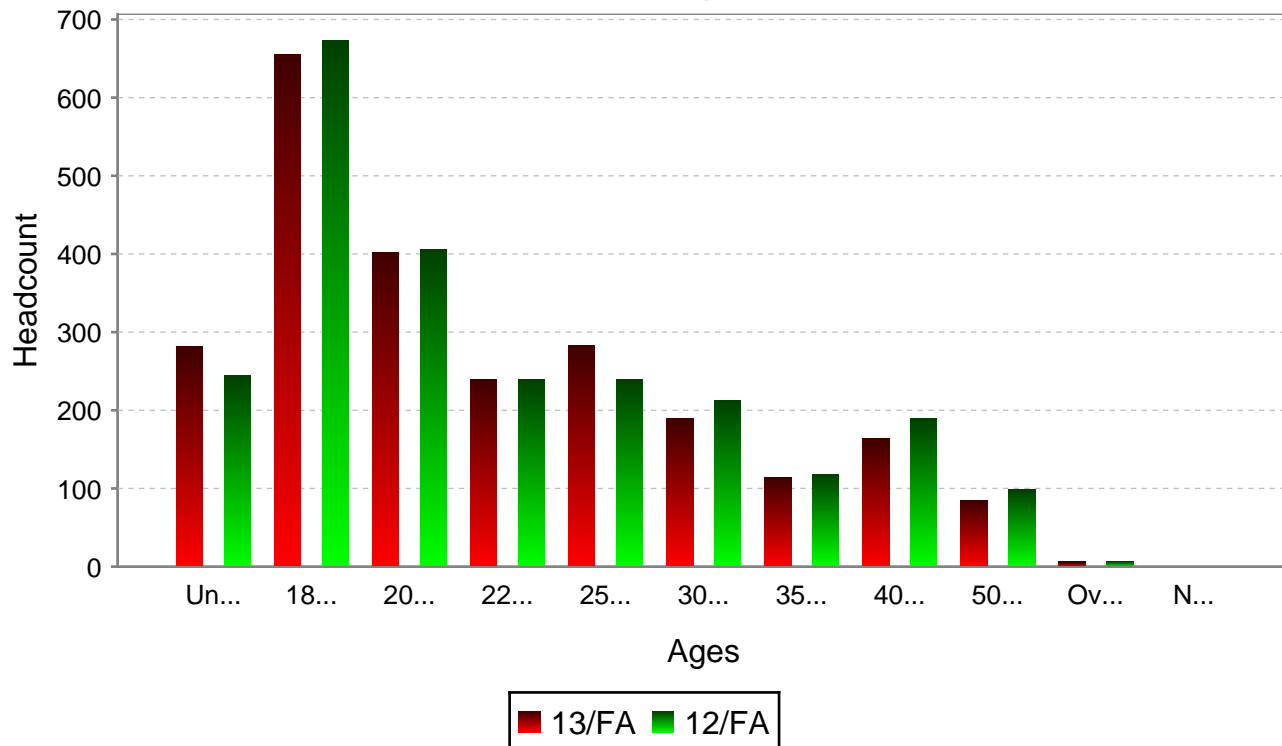

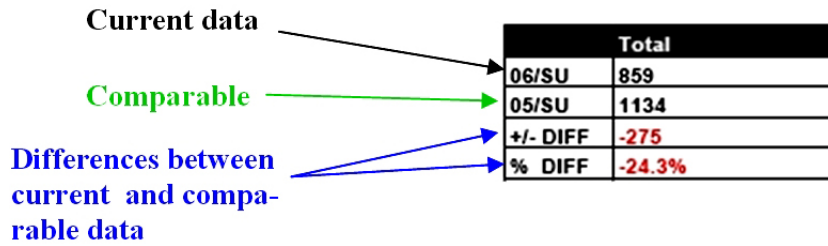
