4. What causes the dips in the enrollment trend lines? After Mon, 16 Dec 2013, the fees due date, the data reflects the removal of unpaid students from the system, hence the dip in the overall total enrollment figures. This 'purging' is subsequently carried out every day till mid semester.

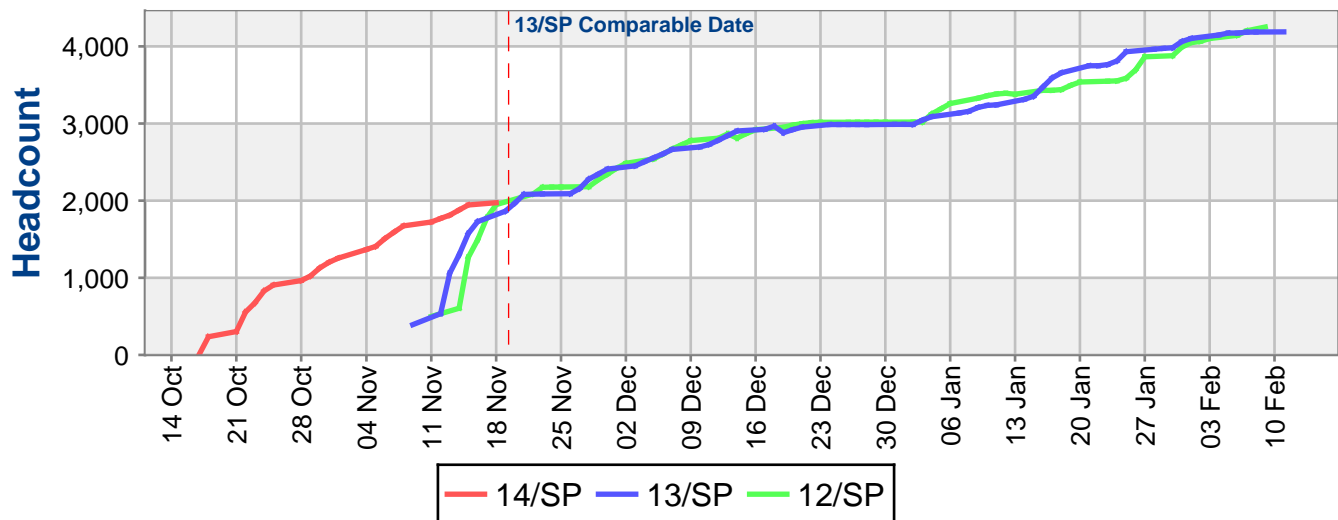

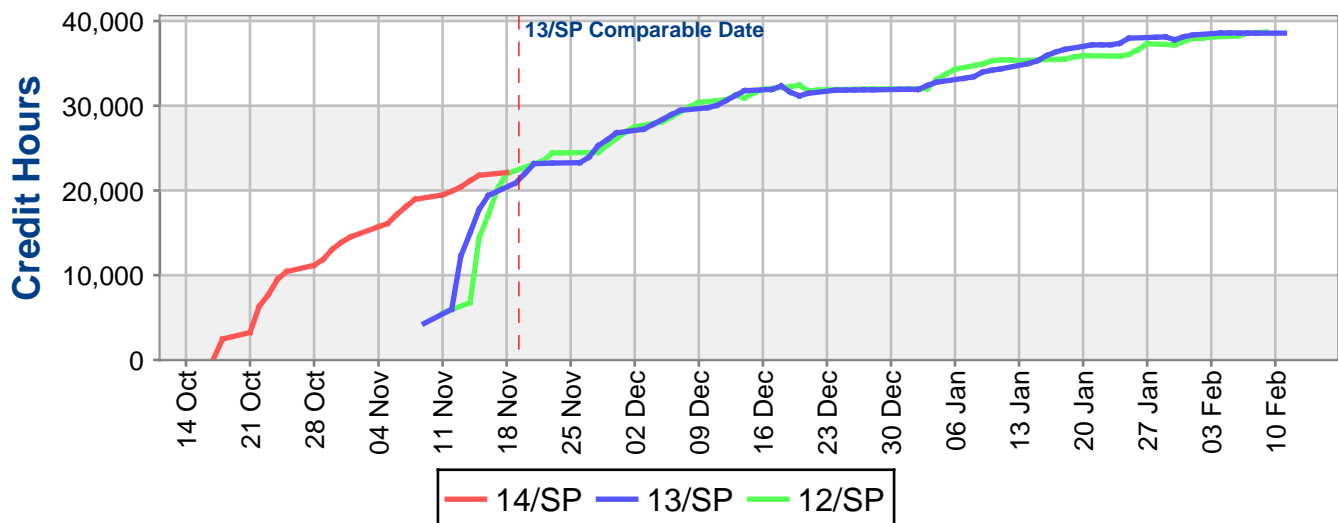
Q. If there are 100 days to go to the start of term and we have enrolled 950 students how do we determine if we are up or down compared to last year?

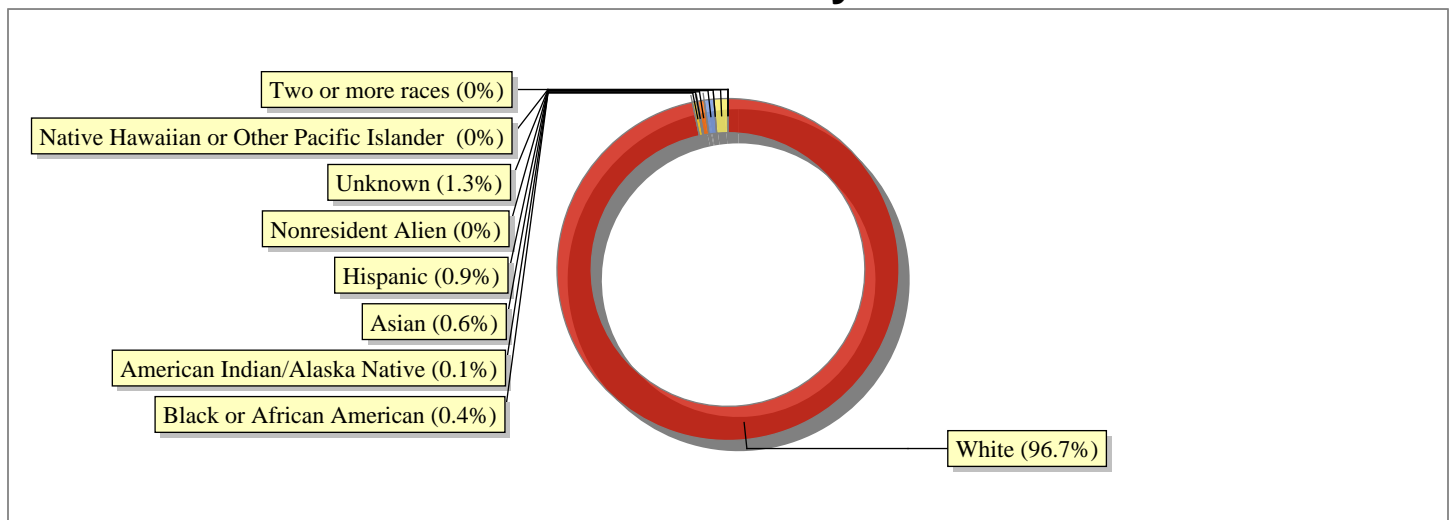

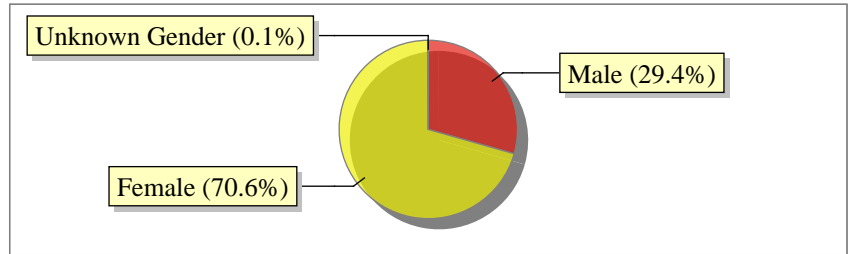

% Gender



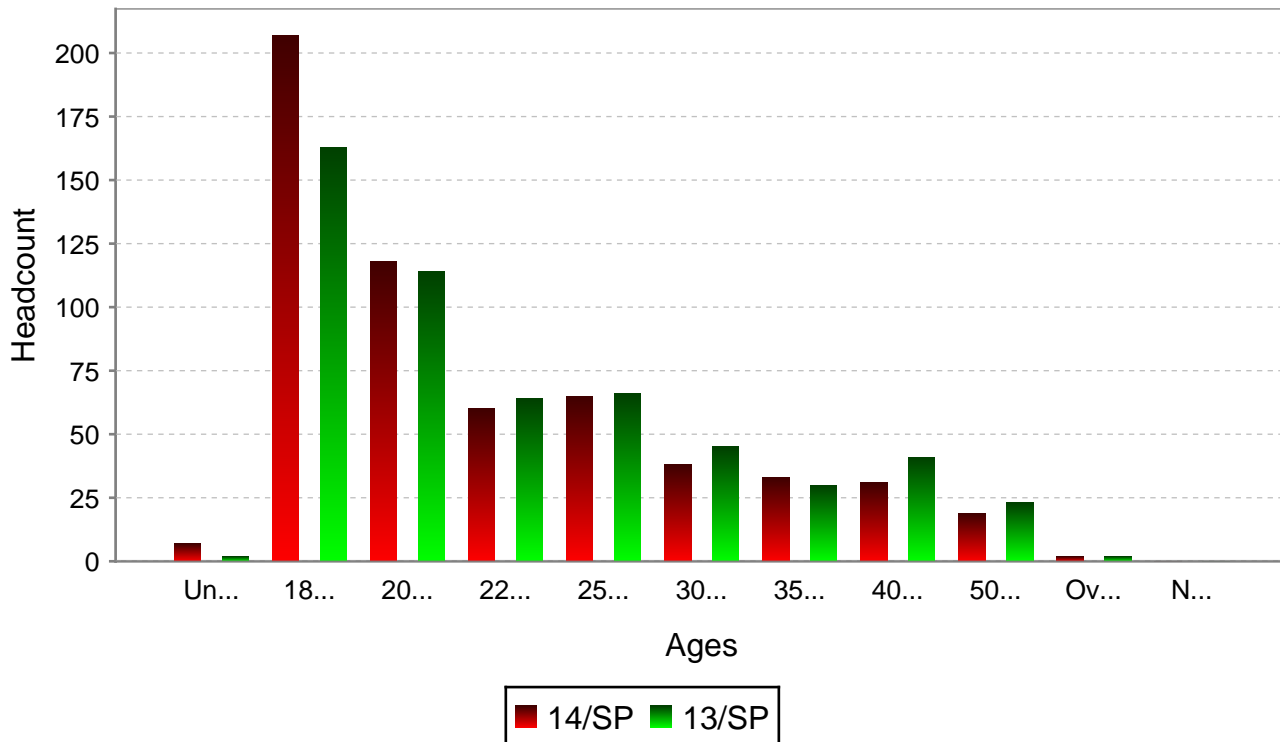

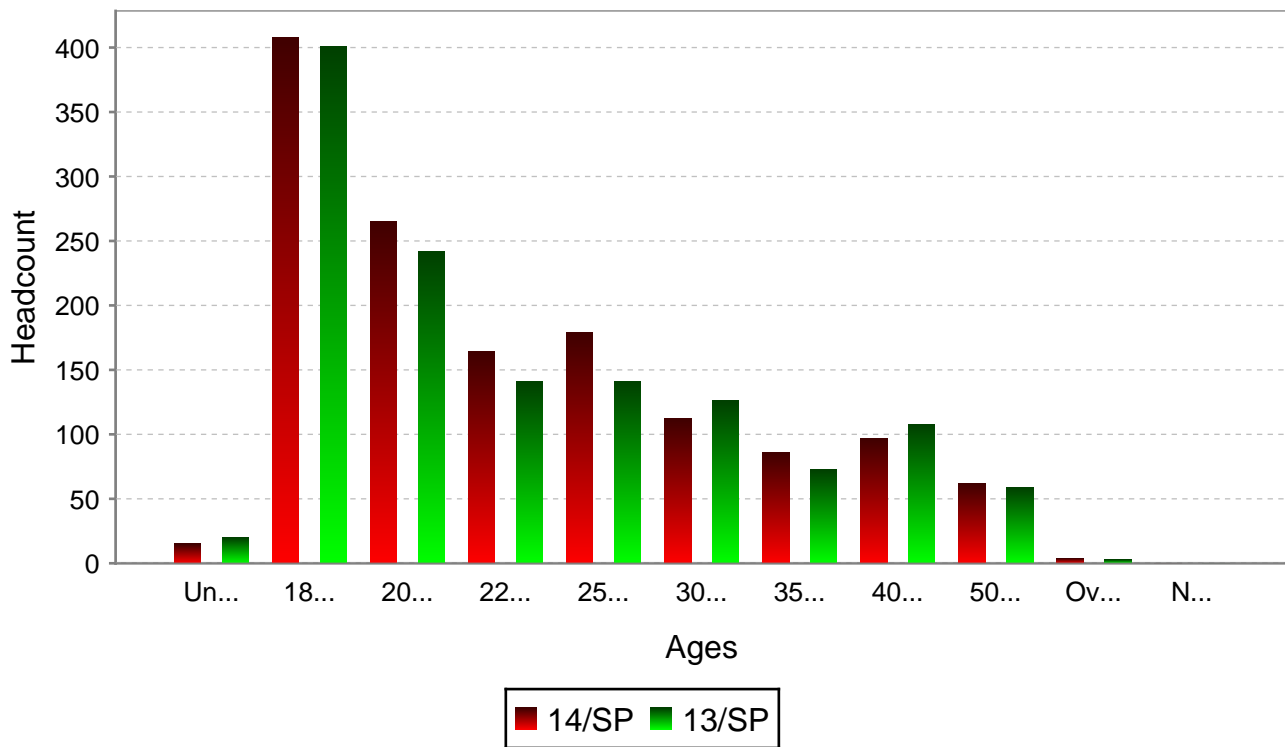
