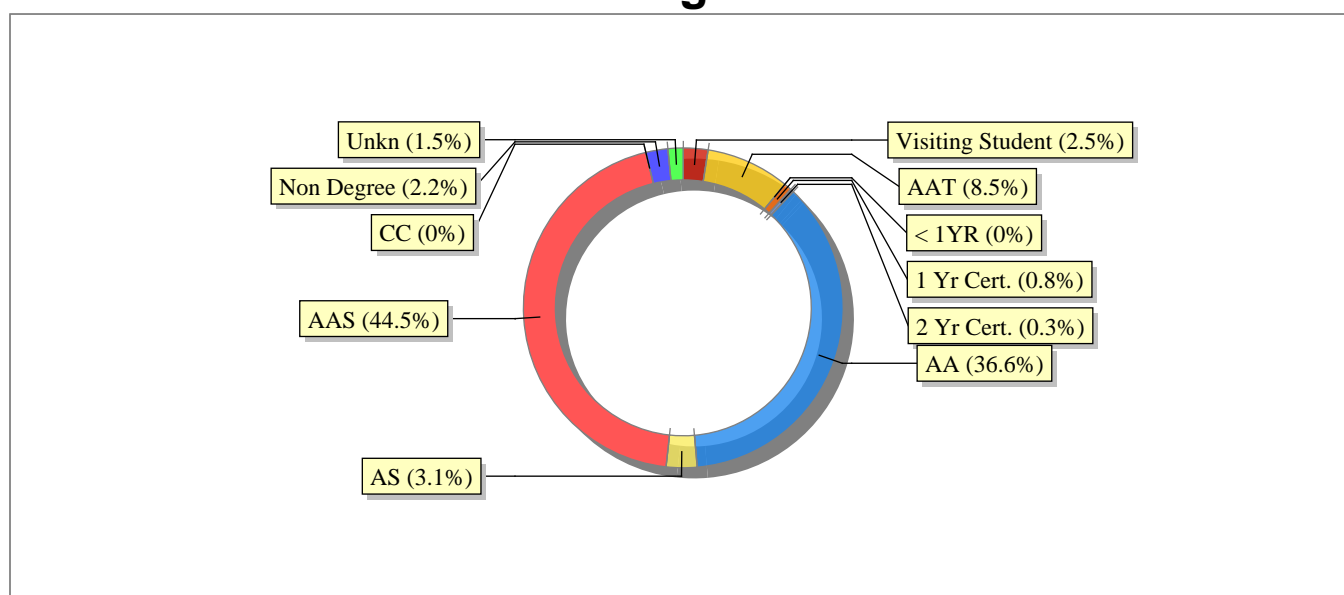

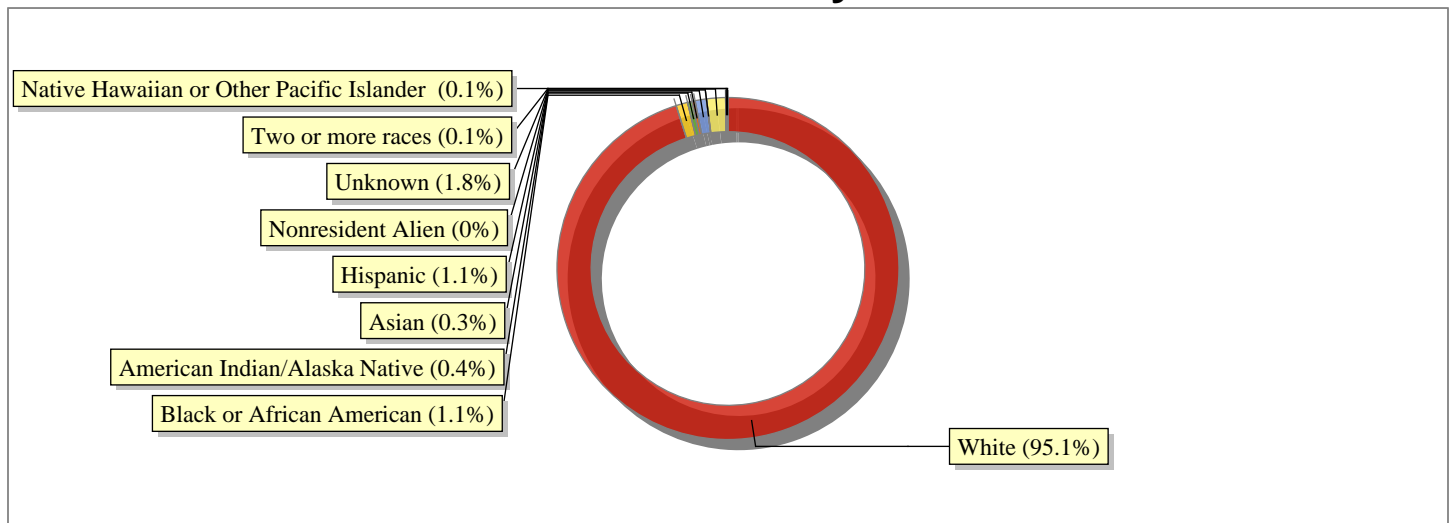

### % Ethnicity

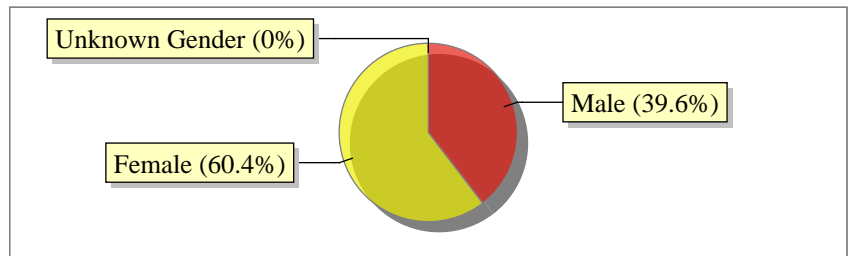

#### % Gender



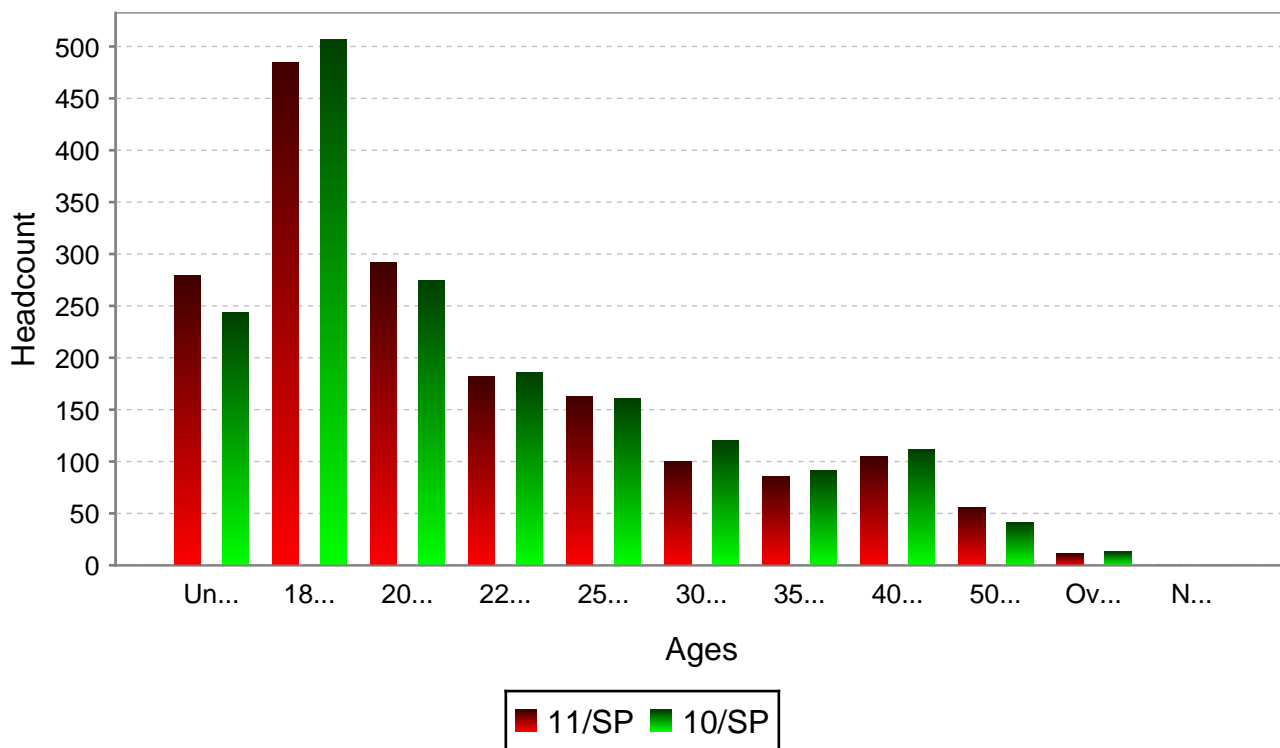

#### Male Ages



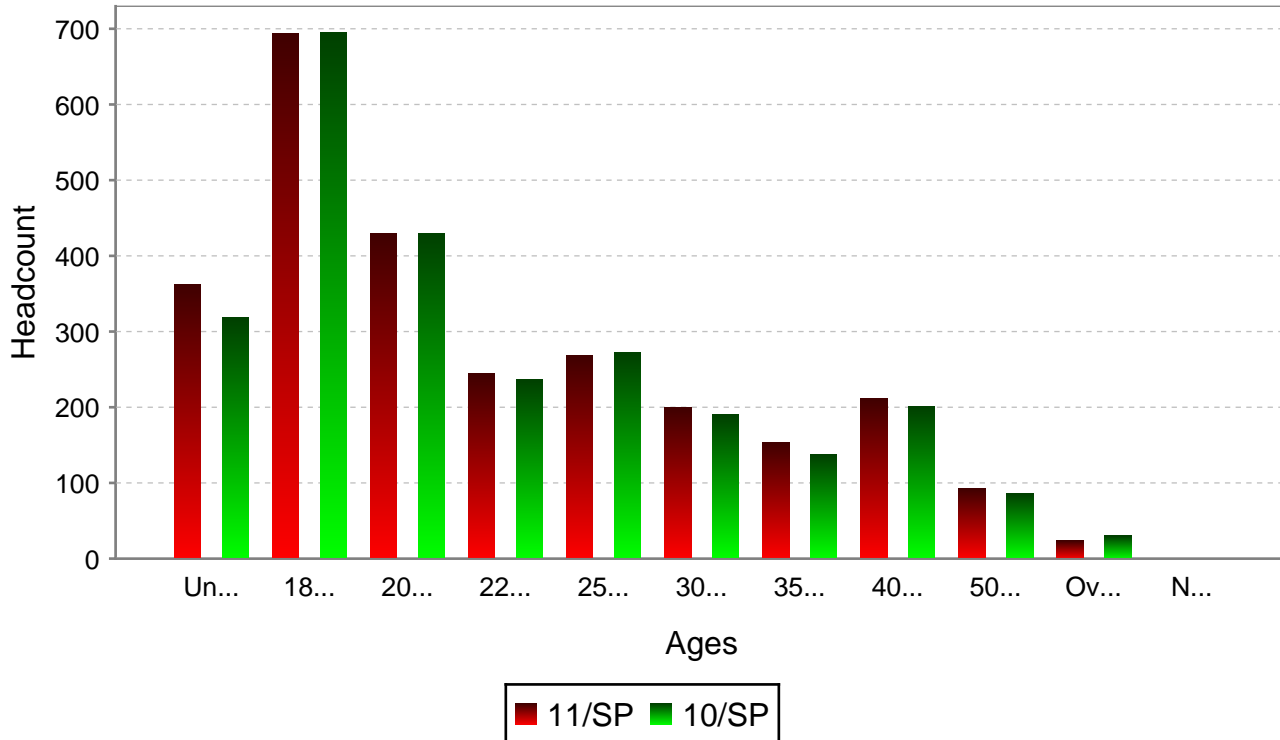
