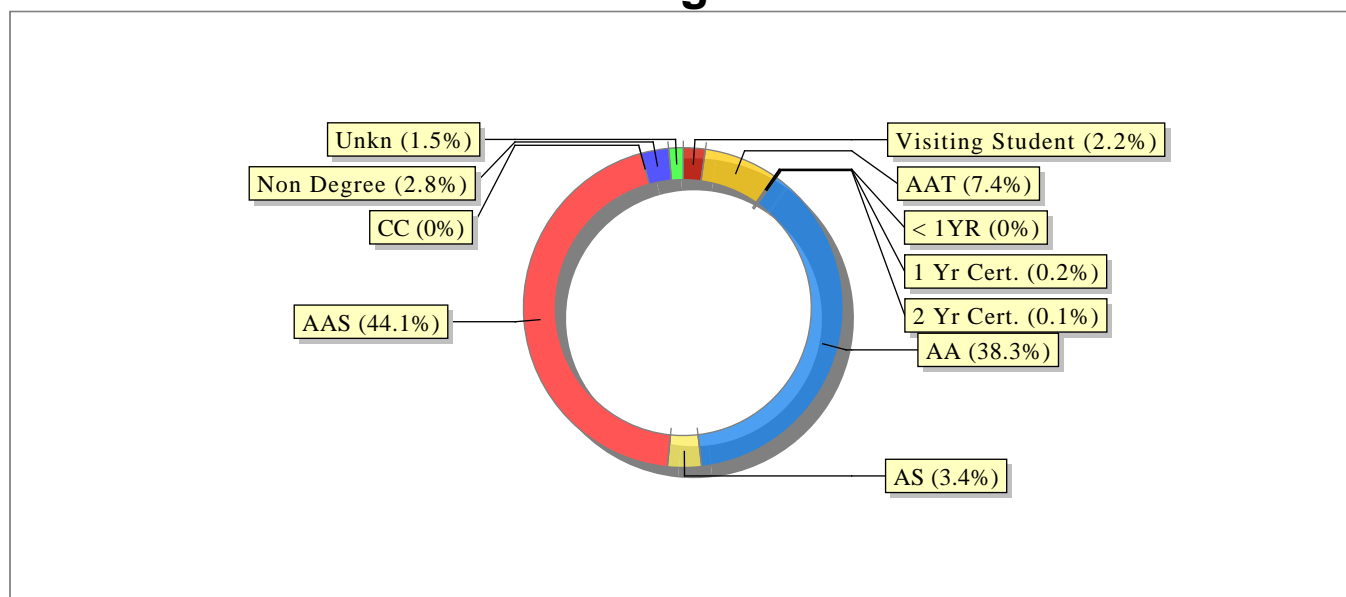

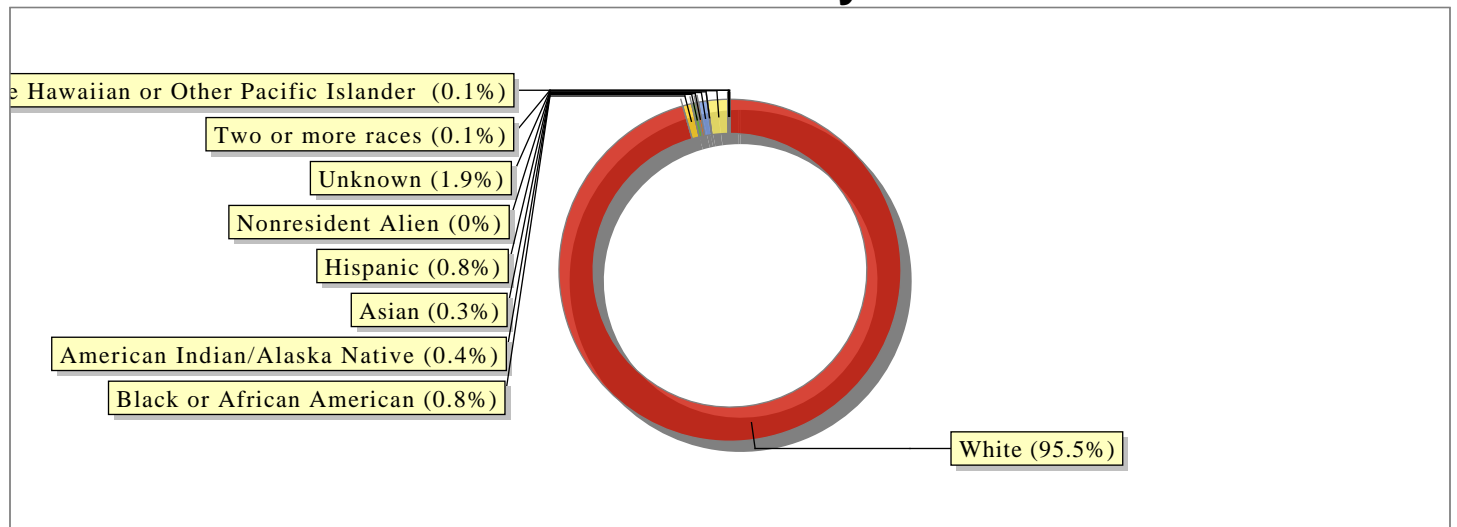

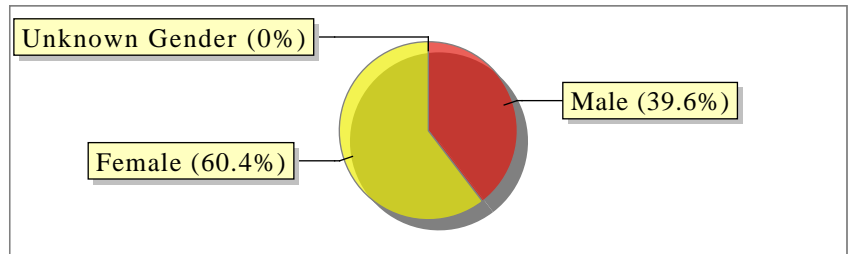

% Gender



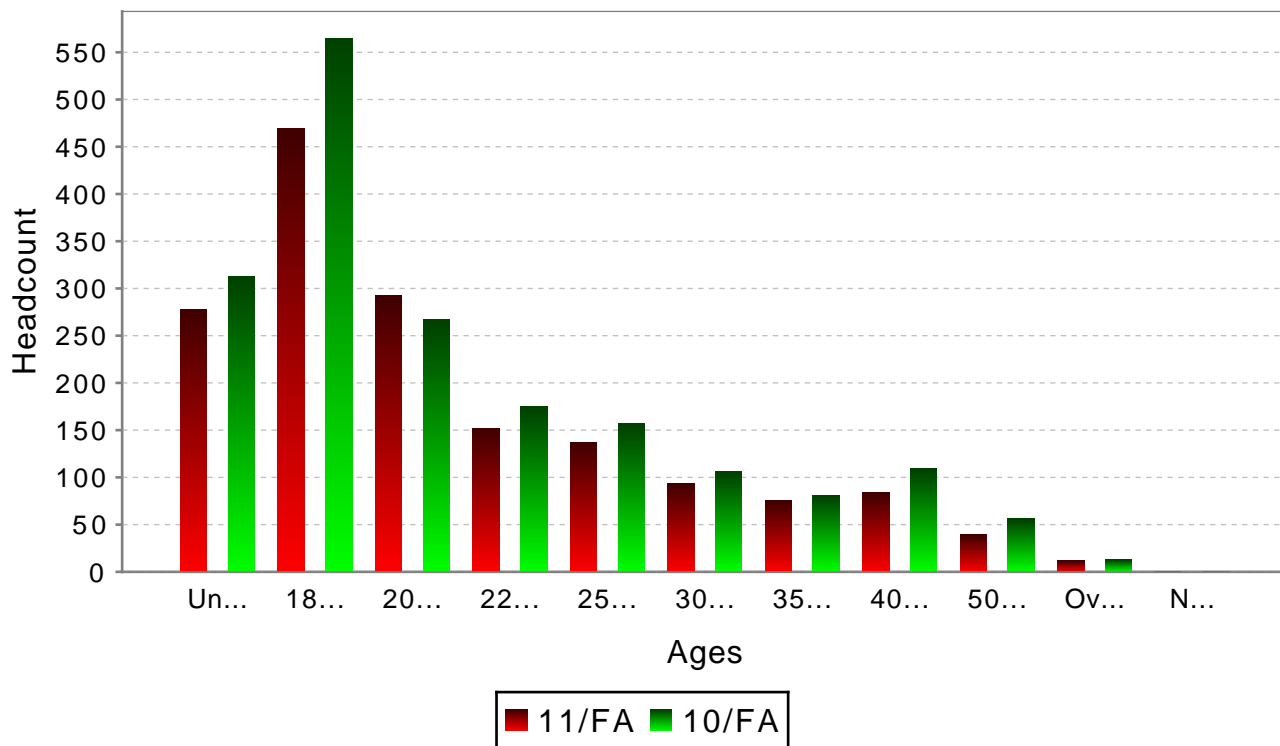

Male Ages



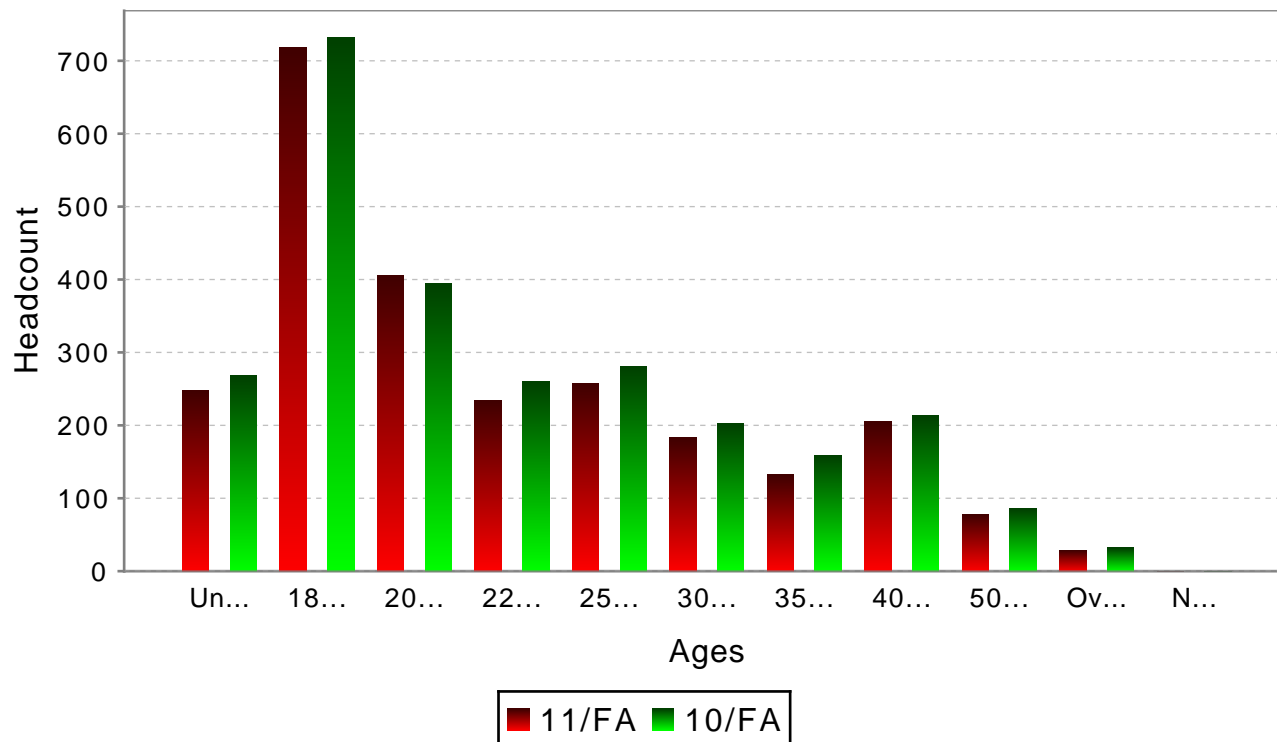
