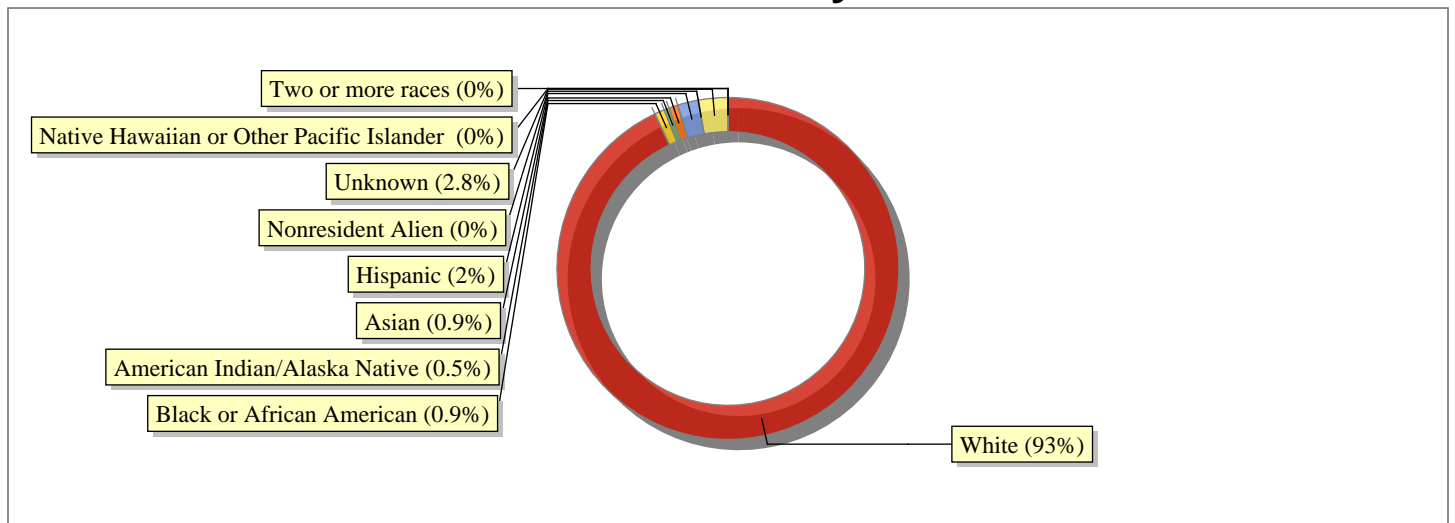

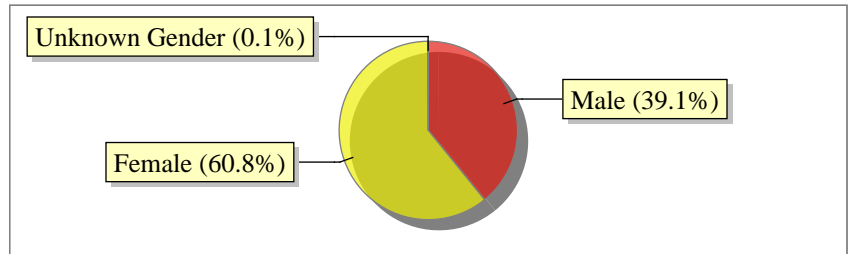

% Gender



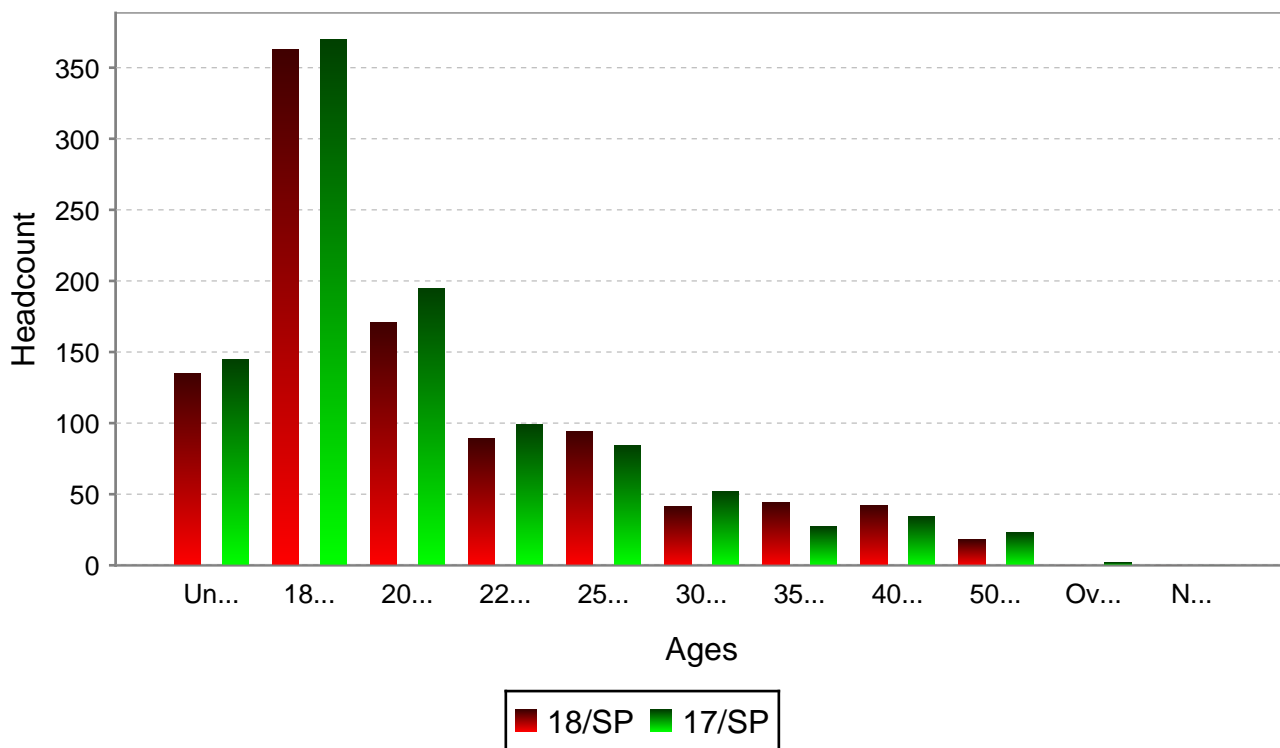

Male Ages



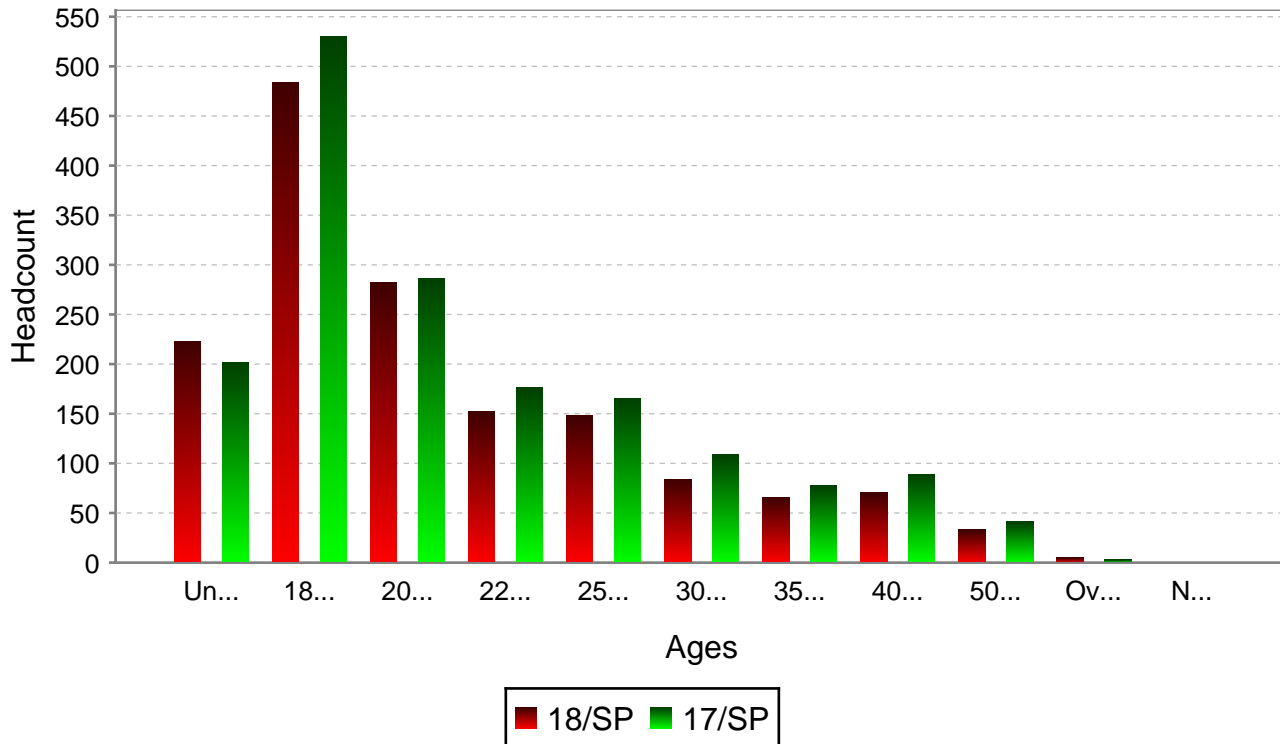
