- Maximum award not to exceed 60 hours or two years
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Completed or have applied for graduation with an eligible UMSL articulated degree from a two-year college the semester applying. Eligible UMSL articulated degrees include:
 - UMSL/ECC AFA to BFA Program
 - UMSL/ECC AFA Music to Bachelors in Music
 - UMSL/ECC Associate of Arts in Business to BSBA Business, BSIS & BSA
 - Statewide Articulation Agreements including AA and AAT
- The ECC president chooses one recipient.
- One award each fall semester and one award each spring semester
- Submit scholarship application by **March 15 for fall semester**. Nominations submitted to UMSL by April 1. Must be admitted to UMSL by April 1.
- Submit scholarship application by **October 15 for spring semester**. Nominations submitted to UMSL by November 1. Must be admitted to UMSL by November 1.
- To maintain the scholarship, recipients must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours annually at UMSL between the fall and spring semesters. In addition, they must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.
