- A documented determination of independence made by a financial aid administrator at another institution in the same or prior away year
- Utility bills, health insurance, or other documents that demonstrate a separation from parents or legal guardians
- Written statement on official letterhead from a State, County or Tribal welfare agency
- Written statement on official letterhead from an independent living case worker who supports current and former foster youth with transition to adulthood
- Written statement on official letterhead from a public or private agency, facility, or program servicing the victims of abuse, neglect, assault, or violence
