Get your Eye Exam-Early detection is the key to protecting your vision from damage caused by glaucoma.

Did You Know...

Vision loss is caused by damage to the optic nerve—this nerve acts like an electric cable with over a million wires.

It is estimated that over 2.2 million Americans have glaucoma but only half of those know they have it.

In the United States, more than 120,000 people are blind from glaucoma, which accounts for 9-12% of all cases of blindness.

High risk groups include African Americans, people over 60, family members of those who are already diagnosed, diabetics, and people who are severely nearsighted.

For now, there is no cure of glaucoma, but medication or surgery can slow or prevent further vision loss.
