The Art of Listening is a uniquely interactive conversation concert that takes audience members on a collaborative quest for musical meaning.



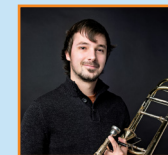
Miguel Espinoza Fusion

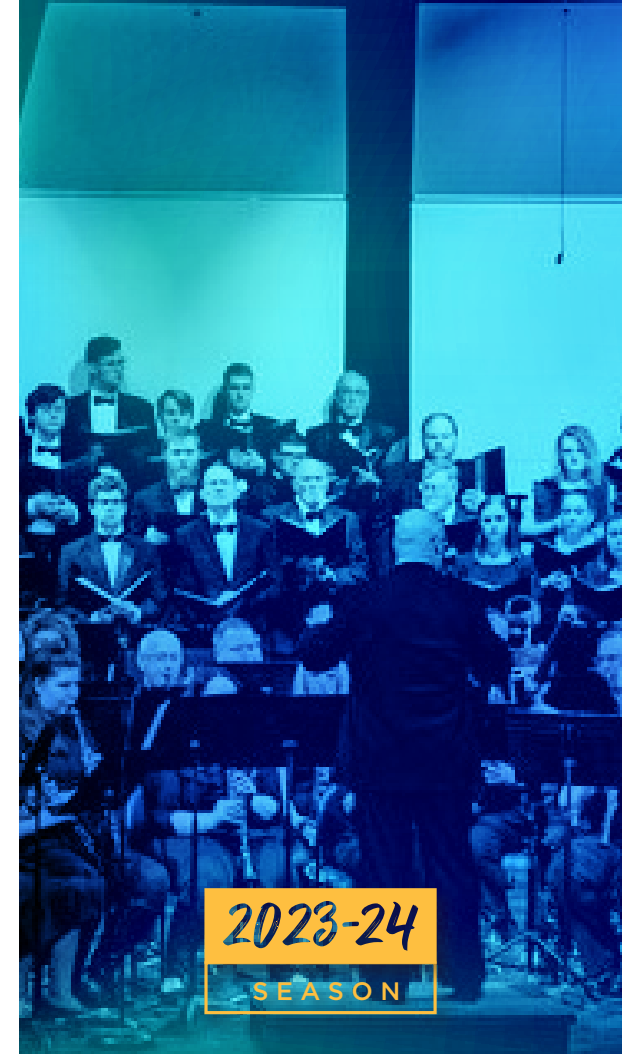
