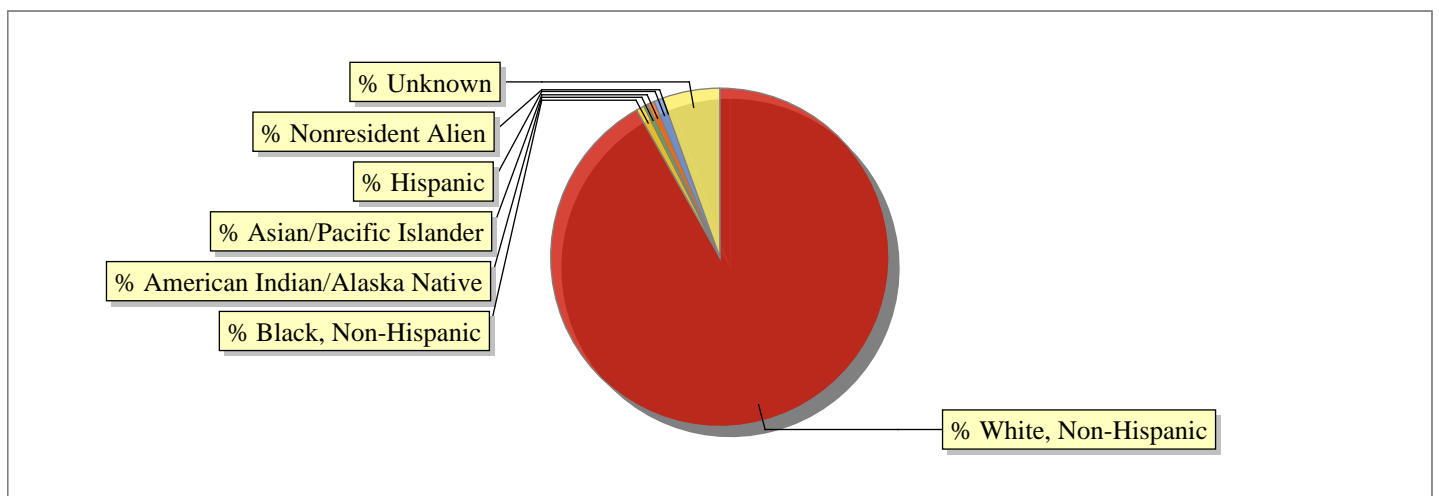

To be considered a first time degree seeking freshman a student must meet the following criteria:

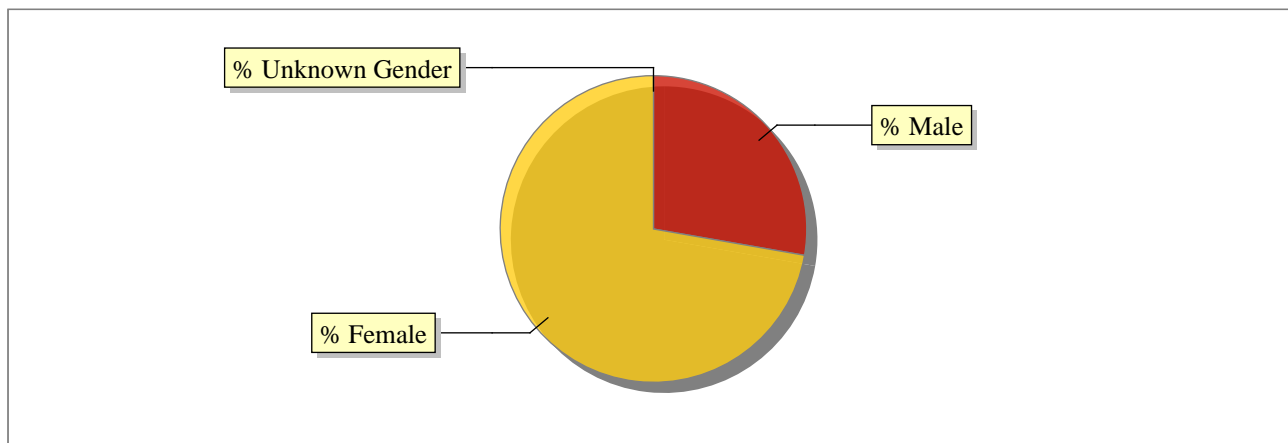
1. Total earned credit hours less than 30.
