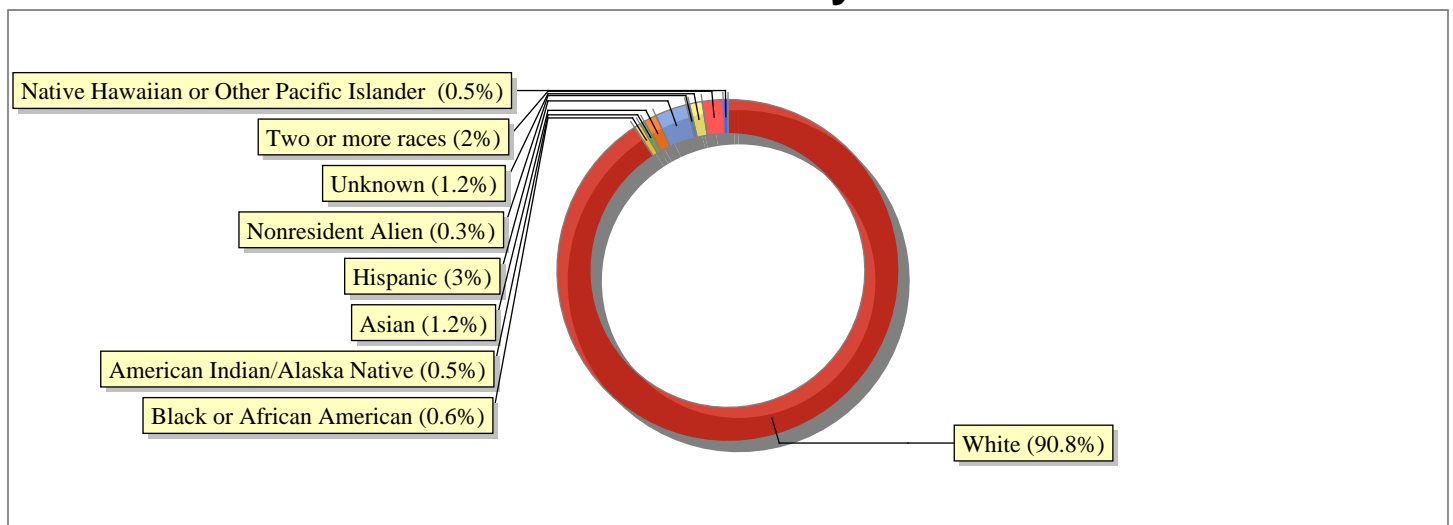

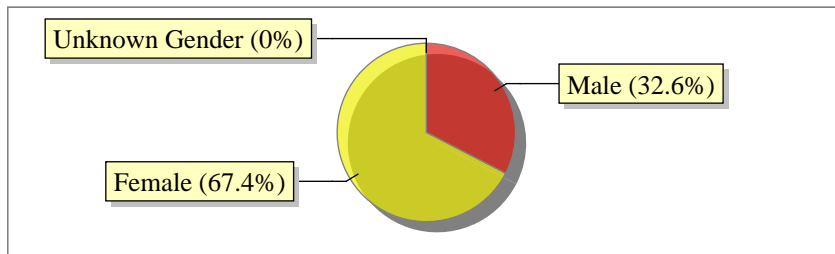

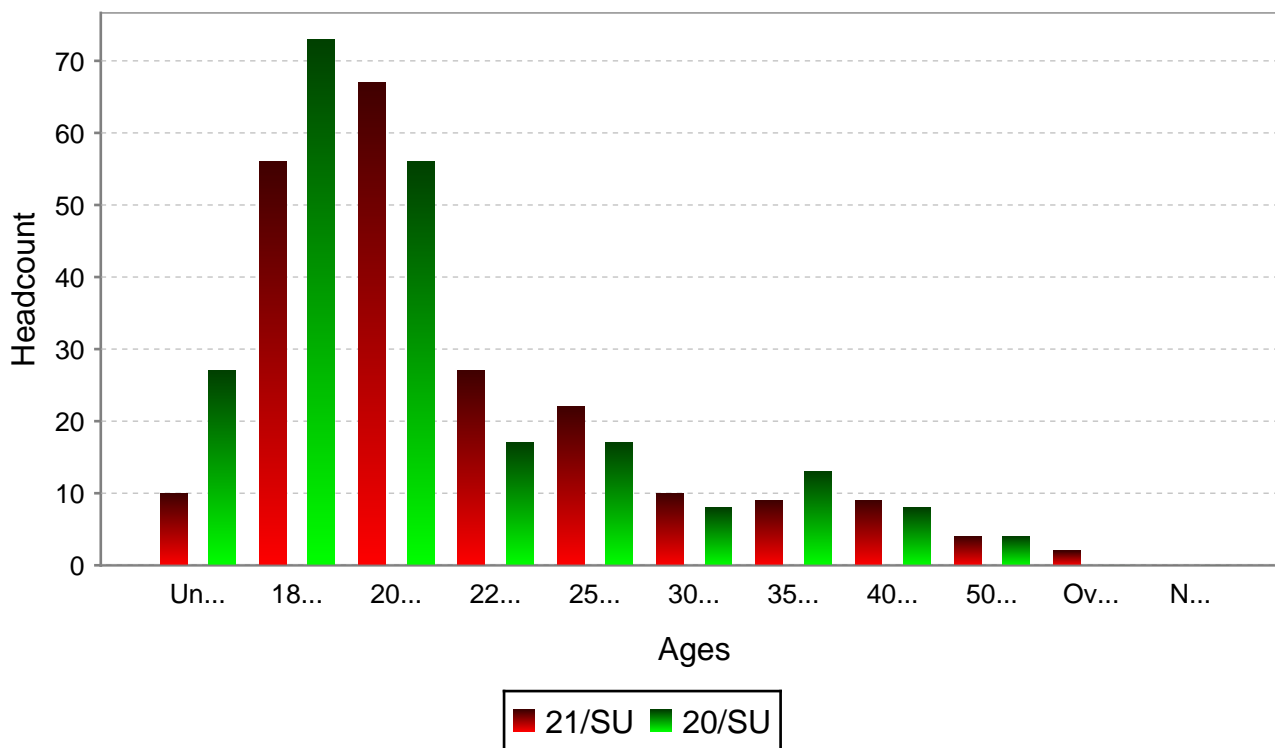

Male Ages



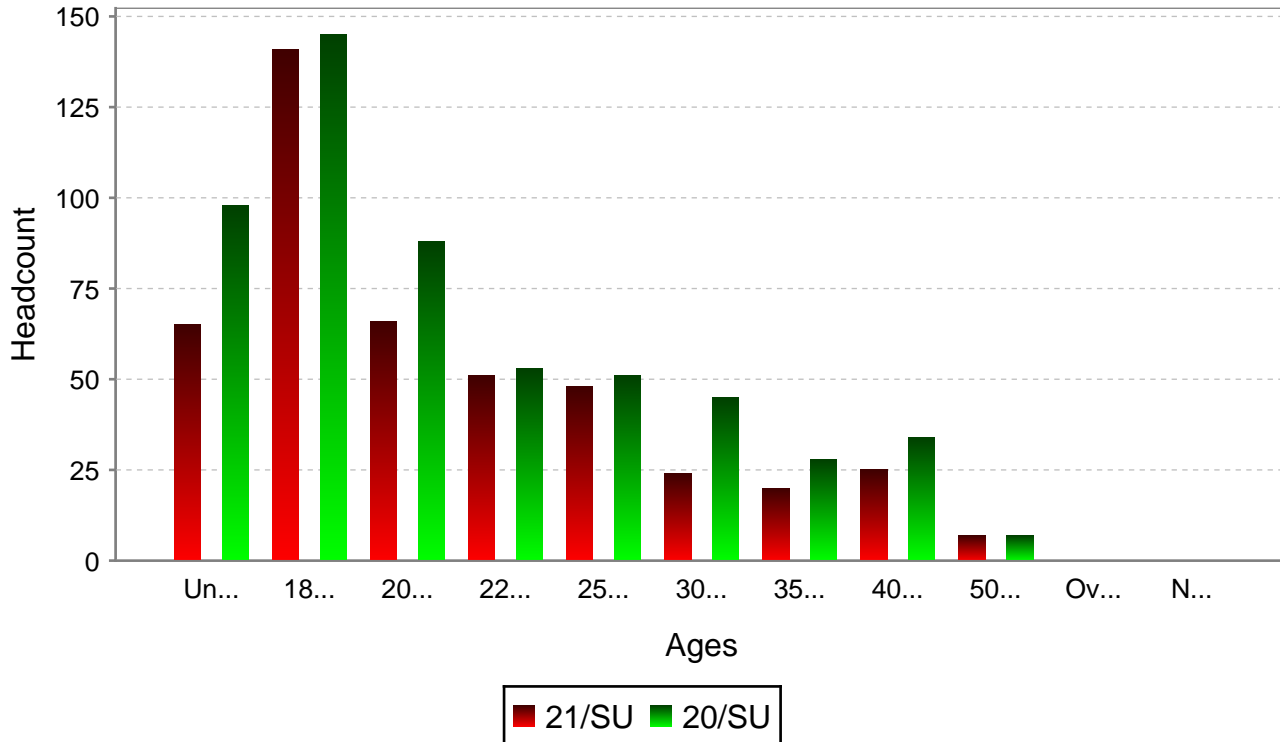
