3. The student is enrolled in a program that will lead to an award of a certificate or a degree.

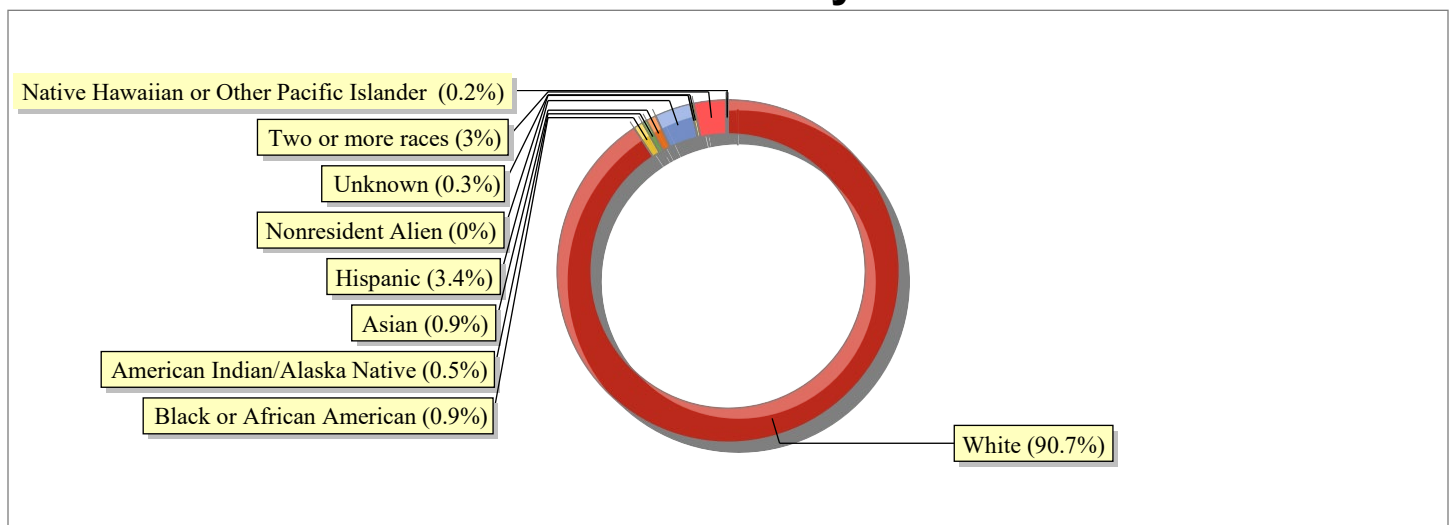

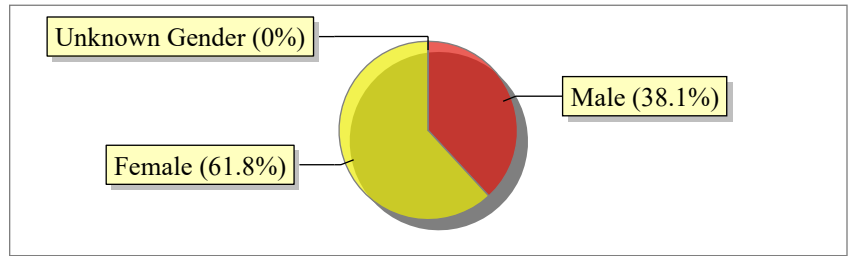

% Gender



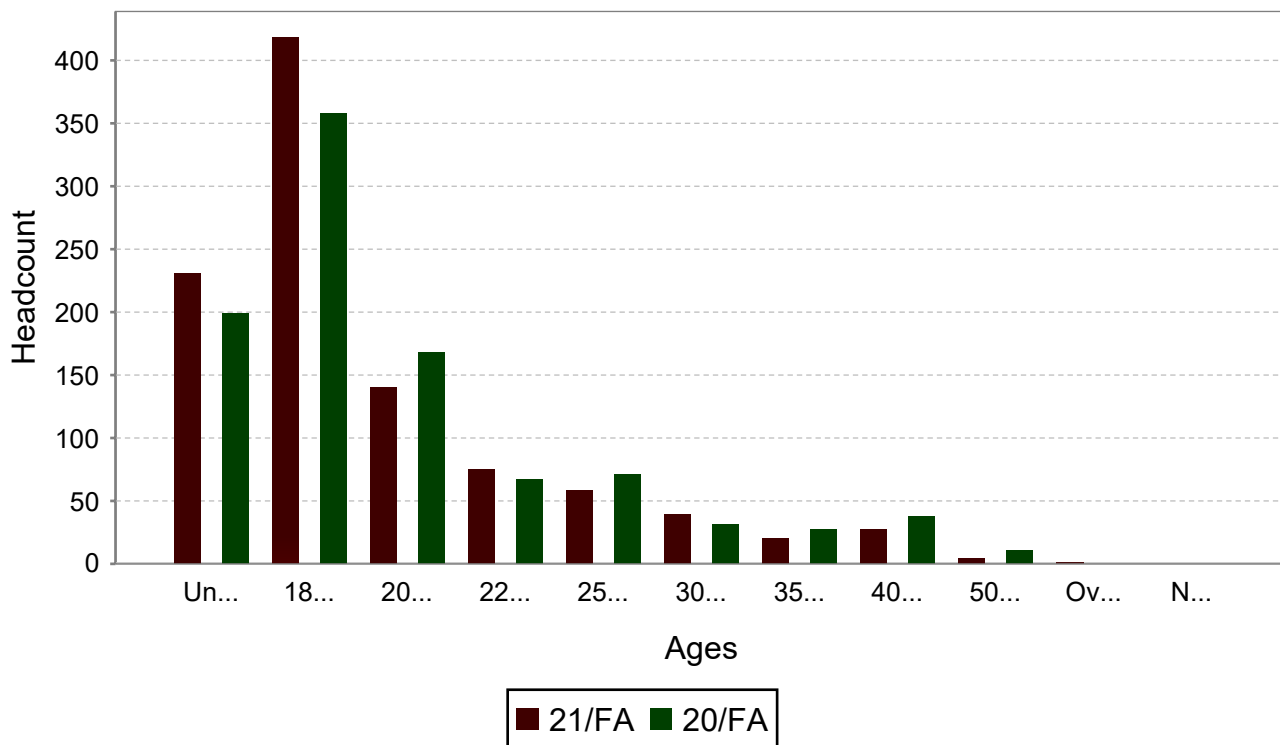

Male Ages



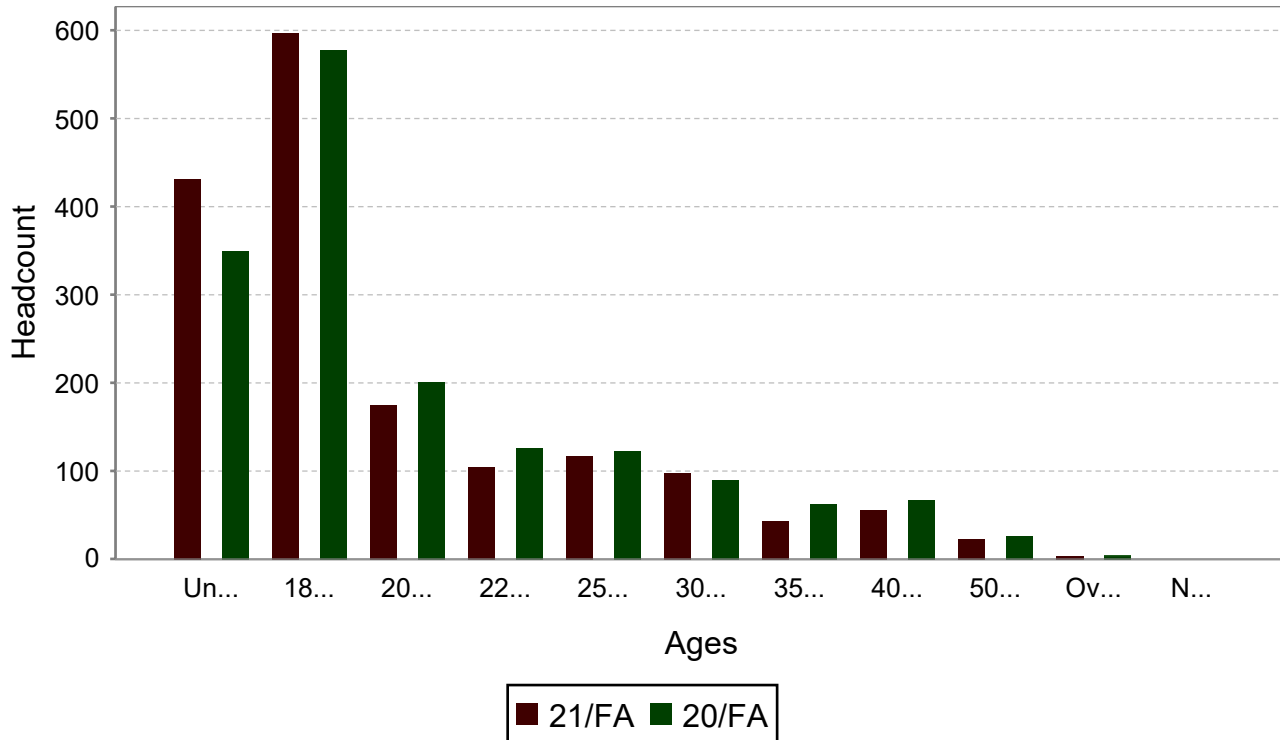
