




Turning the calculator ON...

Click 
the button is
on left-hand side,
bottom of the
calculator



Turning the calculator off...

Click the blue **2nd** button
& then




Secondary function button...

Click the **blue** **2ND** button


When you want to access the functions (in **blue**) for example:

QUIT, LINK, ANGLE, DRAW, MATRIX, ENTRY, MEM, INS, TEST, DISTR, SIN⁻¹, COS⁻¹, TAN⁻¹, π, [,], OFF, etc.

to add, subtract, multiply & divide.




button to subtract




to enter a **negative** number



Navigation arrows...

Allow you to move the cursor on the screen.




The **north** one \wedge , allows you to move **up** on the screen.



The **east** one $>$, allows you to move to the **right**.



The **south** one \vee , Allows you to move **down** on the screen.




The **west** one $<$, Allows you to move to the **left** on the screen.


DELETE

--- removes one character @ a time from home screen



Use *arrow keys*  to move to character to be deleted,
Click delete  button.


Repeat for each character
to be deleted.


CLEAR

--- removes one line from home screen



Arrow  to the line you want to clear


& click the  button
