### TYPES OF DEGREES AND CERTIFICATES OFFERED

The Associate of Arts (AA) degree is the institutional transfer degree.

The **Associate of Arts in Teaching (AAT)** degree is the institutional transfer degree for students preparing to study in teacher education programs.

The **Associate of Fine Arts** (**AFA**) degree is a specifically articulated degree with the University of Missouri-St. Louis. It includes a general education core tailored to students interested in study in a Bachelor of Fine Arts program and the necessary coursework in the fine arts. The degree includes a variety of elective coursework appropriate for the specialized areas of studio and graphic arts.

The **Associate of Science** (**AS**) degree is the institutional preengineering degree.

The **Associate of Applied Science (AAS)** degree is the career and workforce preparation degree.

**Certificate of Specialization** is a career/technical program consisting of up to twenty-nine credit hours, designed to prepare students for entry-level employment. (Formerly referred to as the One-Year Certificate.)

**Certificate of Achievement** is a career/technical program consisting of thirty to fifty-nine credit hours, designed to prepare students for entry-level employment. (Formerly referred to as the Two-Year Certificate.)
