Selection Process

Enrollment in the MHPC MLT Program is limited and the Program may not be able to offer admission to all qualified applicants. Only students meeting all admission criteria and submitting all required application items by May 15th deadline will be considered. Completed applications will be evaluated utilizing selection criteria established in advance by the MLT admissions committee. Applicants are ranked using the same admission criteria. Selection procedures and rankings are grouped by clinical affiliate location in order to meet accreditation standards.

Application review begins as soon as the students packet arrives at the MLT Program office in Mexico, MO. Each section of the Application Score Sheet (refer to the form at the end of this packet) is assigned a point value (e.g., GPA, general education coursework, etc.) and a preliminary ranking score is determined for each applicant. The MLT admissions committee meets at the close of the application acceptance timeframe, discuss applicant rankings and select the class. Decisions of the MLT Admissions Committee are final. The MLT Program office will notify applicants of their status by email during the first week of June.

Failure to submit required documentation by the May 15th established deadline may result in subsequent denial of official acceptance into the MLT program.

1. Apply for "Home" Community College admission

In order to be eligible to apply for the MLT Program, the applicant must be admitted into one of the consortium community college of their choosing (termed "home" campus) and have completed all the necessary pre-requisite requirements.

2. Submit transcripts

When applying to the "home" college admission office for pre-requisite MLT Program requirements, students must submit high school and official college transcripts. This is a necessary step in preparation for MLT Program admission. These official transcripts for all previous colleges attended (including dual credit courses) must be on file at the "home" college prior to the May 15th MLT application deadline. It may take a several weeks for official transcripts to be sent. It is the student's responsibility to ensure transcripts arrive in a timely manner prior to the application deadline.

3. Application for Program Admission

Complete the application on the following pages. All required components to this application will be submitted in <u>one email</u> or <u>enclosed in one envelope</u>. Multiple submissions or missing required components will not be accepted.

Be advised that clinical facilities will request a drug screen and additional background checks for MLT students doing clinical practicums in their facilities. This will be at the student's expense. The student understands that all information contained in this application, high school, college or university transcripts will be presented to the admissions committee for review and that you hear by grant permission to have your records reviewed.

Page 1 & 3 of the Application for Program Admission form upon completion by the student should be emailed to the contact information listed on the first page of this packet.

Page 2 of the Application for Program Admission form – Section E is to be completed by the applicant and submitted to their advisor at their "Home" campus. Section F will be filled out by their respective advisor and sent to the contact information listed on the first page of this packet.
