 - Root words in biology are often something to look out for
 - Ex. Depressor labii inferioris = a muscle under the lips that lowers them

 - Songs are easy to remember and easy to repeat.
 - Ex.
 - The alphabet song
 - The periodic table song
- Can you make it a game? Can you find a game with it on the internet?
 - Word searches/Cross words
 - Monopoly
