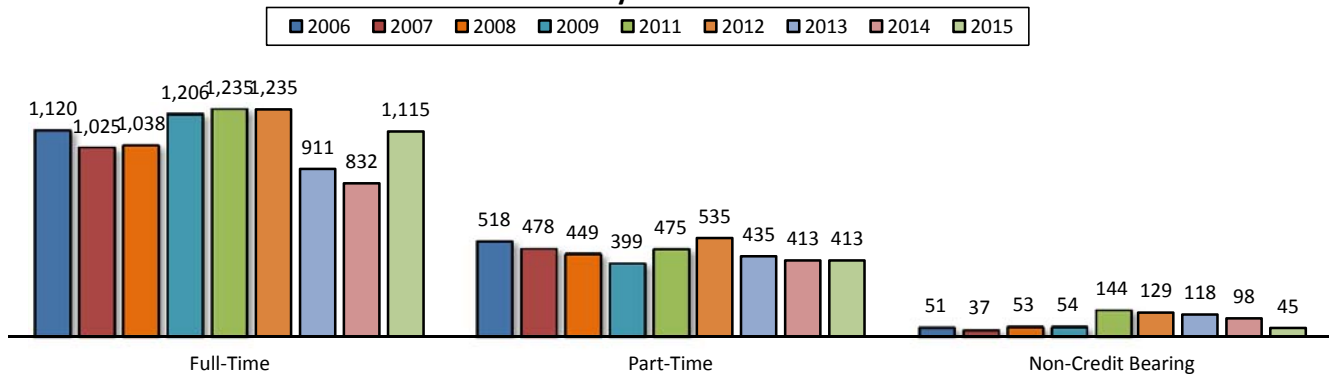

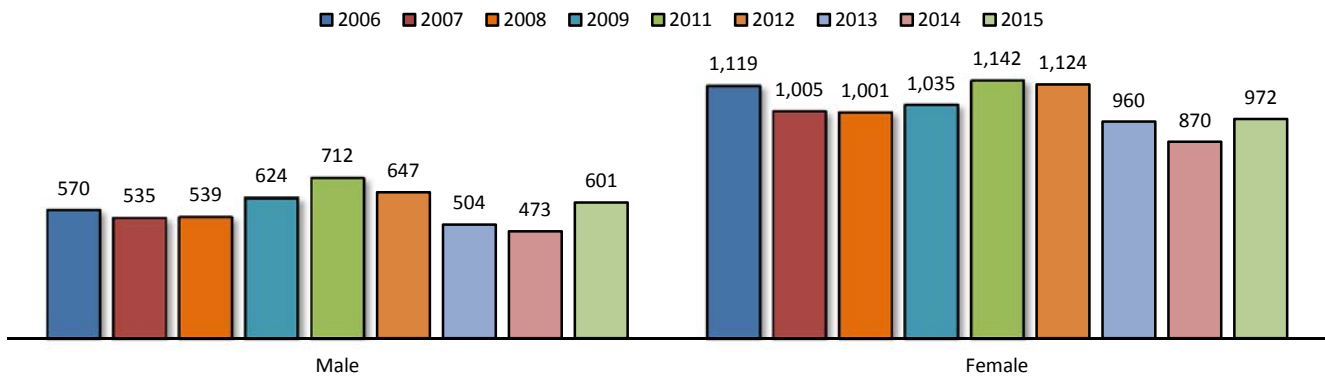

Visitors by Gender



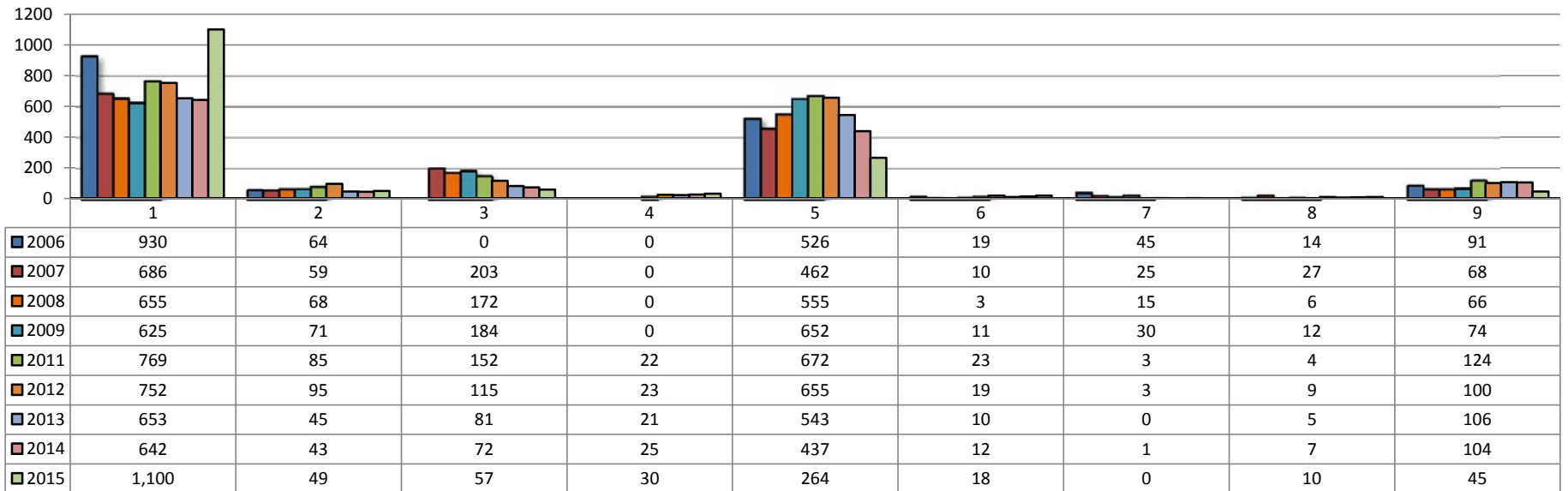

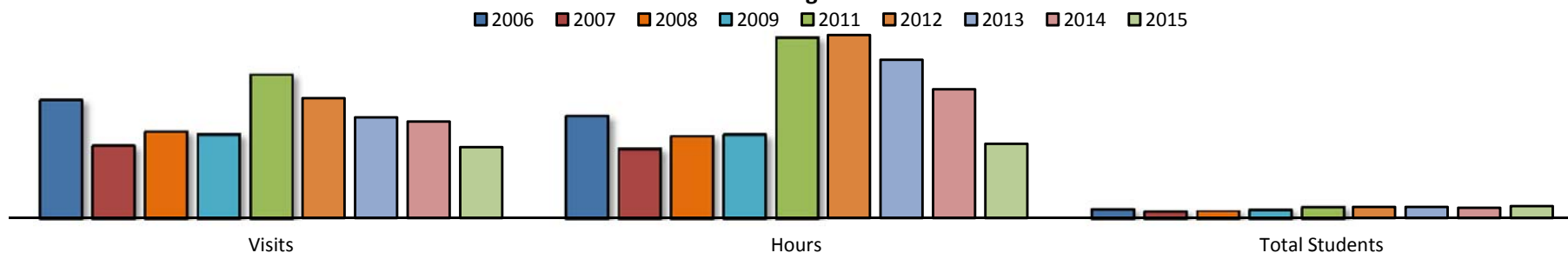

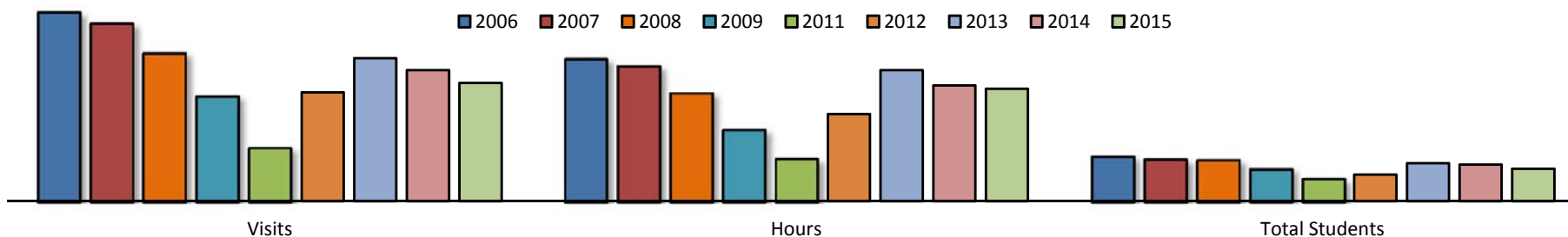

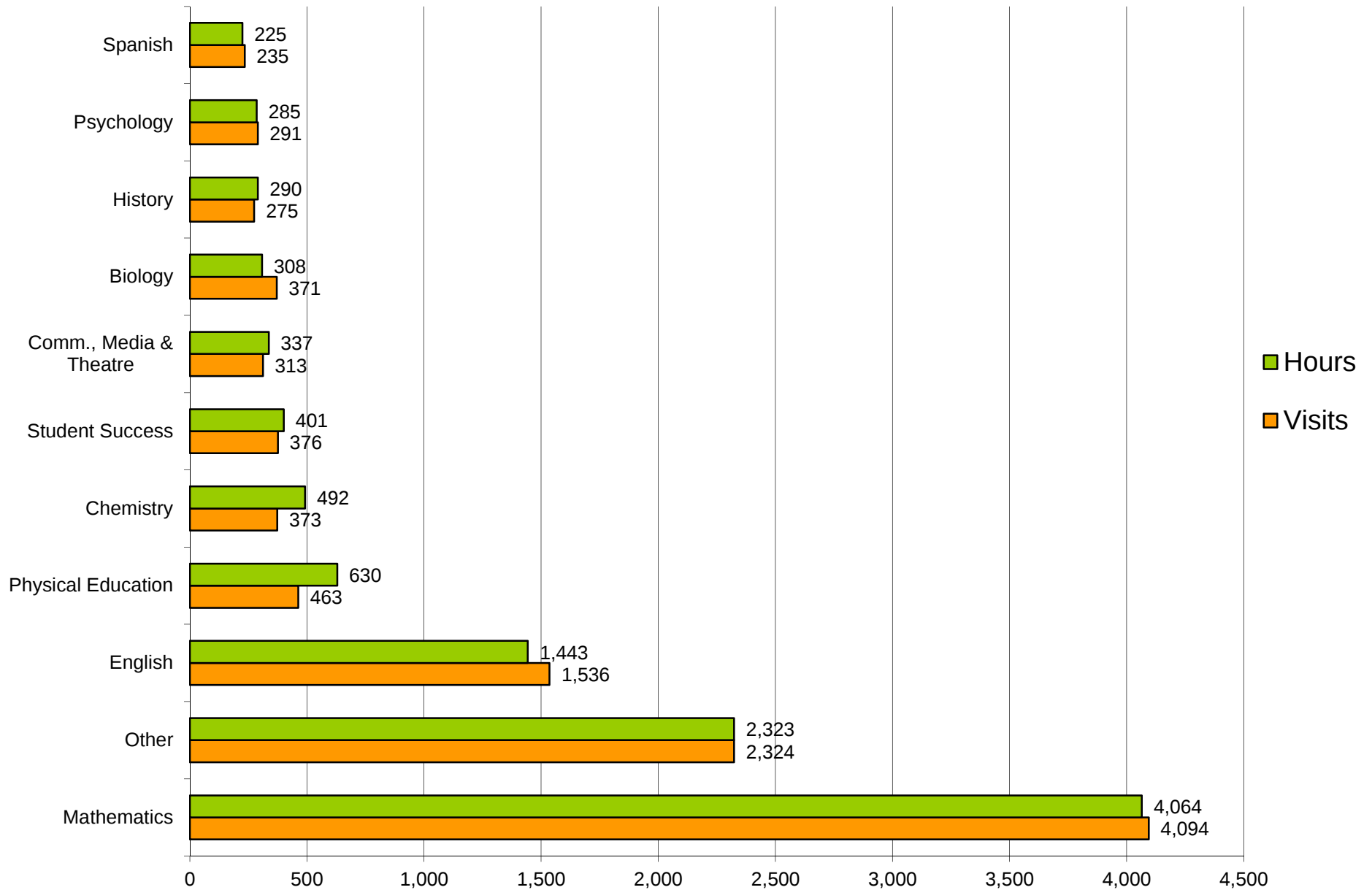
