

EXAM OFFERINGS

ECC COURSE EXAMS

We administer exams for individual students enrolled in courses of all modalities. We administer make-up exams and exams for students on-file accommodations.

PLACEMENT TESTING

East Central College uses multiple measures to advise and enroll students into reading, writing, and math classes A consultation with the Admissions department is required before attempting the placement test.

CREDIT BY EXAM

We administer both CLEP and DSST exams, allowing students to earn college credit by exam, saving tuition dollars and time. Students seeking to earn credit by exam should verify their college or university's requirements prior to paying for and scheduling the exam.

ALLIED HEALTH EXAMS

We partner with the Department of Nursing to administer the HESI RN-A2, the HESI LPN-to-RN Mobility, the HESI PN-A2, and the TEAS. The exams are entrance exams into the Registered Nursing Program, the LPN to RN Bridge Program, the Practical Nursing Program, the Radiologic Program, and the Surgical Program.



PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION EXAMS

We are an authorized Pearson VUE and Scantron Testing Center, which enables us to administer thousands of professional certification exams from over 450 credentialing authorities in virtually every industry.

MISSOURI EDUCATION ASSESSMENTS

We administer the MoGEA for candidates seeking entry into a Missouri educator program, the MOCAs for candidates seeking educator certification in Missouri, as well as a skills exam for candidates seeking a Paraprofessional position.

HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY

We administer the HiSET exam for individuals wanting to earn their high schoolequivalency diploma. ECC's Adult Education and Literacy Program offers free HiSETprep courses

TABE

The TABE test (Test of Adult Basic Education) evaluates basic Math, Vocabulary, and Reading skills. Completion of the TABE is required to participate in the Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) program.

PROCTORING FOR OTHER INSTITUTIONS

Students attending courses at other colleges and universities may use our Testing Center as a proctoring site for their exams. A proctoring fee may be applicable.
