ECC offers a 700-hour Missouri P.O.S.T. approved basic training program to become a law enforcement officer!

Students successfully completing the 1-year program which combines theory, experiential learning, and practical applications

- Graduate with a **Certificate of Achievement** in Law Enforcement and 37 hours of college credit
- Are eligible to take the **Missouri Peace Officer License Exam** (MPOLE)
- May opt to earn an **Associate of Applied Science** in Law Enforcement by taking additional general education courses



A selective admission process is utilized

A complete list of requirements is listed in the application including:

- US Citizen at least 20 years old
- Apply for ECC admission and meet placement standards
- Complete the basic training application, fitness assessment, and interview
- Satisfactory criminal background check, drug screening, and physical once accepted to the program
