Missouri's Adult Learning Landscape

Updated 10/30/2024

- Approximately 312,000 workforce-aged adults lack a high school education in Missouri.
- Adults with no diploma or equivalency are unemployed at a rate nearly three times higher than those
 with at least a bachelor's degree. In Missouri, adults with a diploma or equivalency earn approximately
 \$10,000 more a year.²
- Missouri serves adult learners through these primary models: Adult Education & Literacy (AEL), Adult High Schools, and the Workforce Diploma program.
- Missouri has made significant efforts to increase the number of adult education participants who
 receive relevant workforce training alongside adult education.
