



Paying for College in High School

For Dual Credit & Dual Enrollment Students

Students who are currently finishing high school, home school, or their Missouri HiSET are unable to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) process until they have graduated.

As a result, they are not eligible for traditional grants, scholarships, or loans.

Help is Available

Many colleges provide tuition at a reduced rate for this population of students. For example, ECC provides tuition at half the cost of in-district tuition. Dual Credit students who take classes at their high schools do not pay fees. Dual Enrollment students who take classes at an ECC site or online do pay fees.
