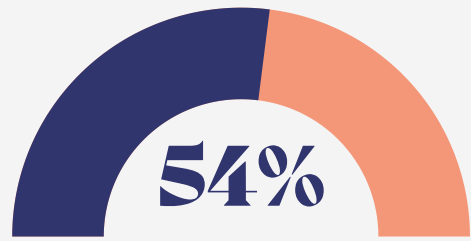

Data Shows High Success Rates in Art and Music Appreciation Courses and Beyond!

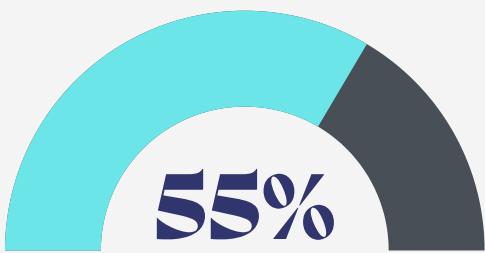
SPRING 2020

The Online Writing Center saw 105 visits, and out of those visits, Art and Music Appreciation counted for 57 / 105 visits, or 54%. The average final grades for these courses came to an A.



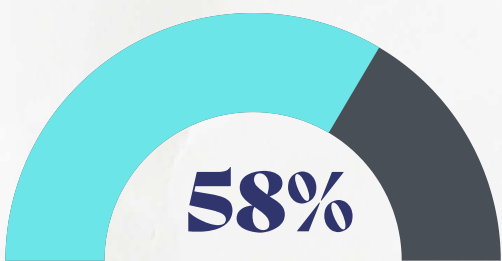
SUMMER 2020

For Appreciation courses, we saw 22 out of 40 total visits, or 55% in the OWC. Again, the average final grade was an A.



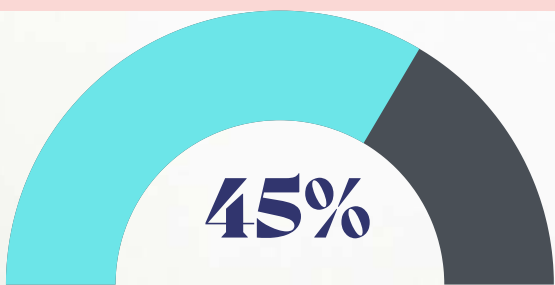
FALL 2020

Music and Art Appreciation Courses reckoned at 75 of our 130 visits. This accounted for 58% of OWC visits. Again, the average final grade in these courses was an A.



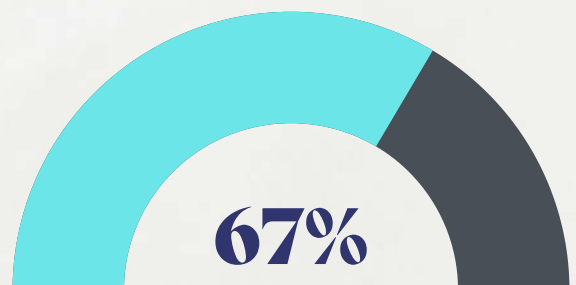
SPRING 2021

The OWC saw 51 Appreciation Course Visits out of 112 total submissions, or 45%. The average final grade was an A.



SUMMER 2021

The OWC saw 30 visits, 20 of which were Appreciation Courses, for 67% of our visits. As you might expect, the average final grade was an A.

Success in Other Courses

Microbiology: 37 Submissions Total for these semesters.
For those students, the average final grades ranged
between A and B.

English Courses: 162 Submissions Total. The average final
grade was an A. This accounts for ENG 101 / 102 courses
as well as Creative Writing and other disciplines in this field.

Other Disciplines: from Sociology to History and Nursing, we
saw similar trends. The more students use the OWC, in
